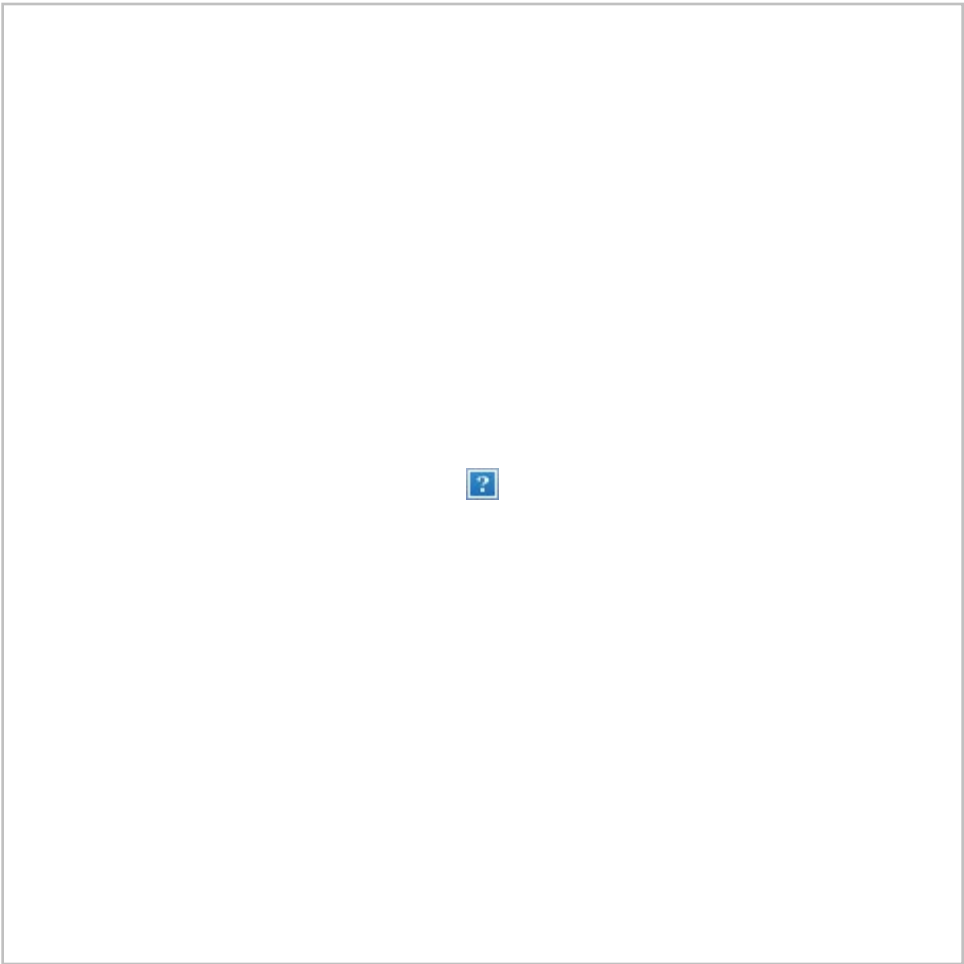

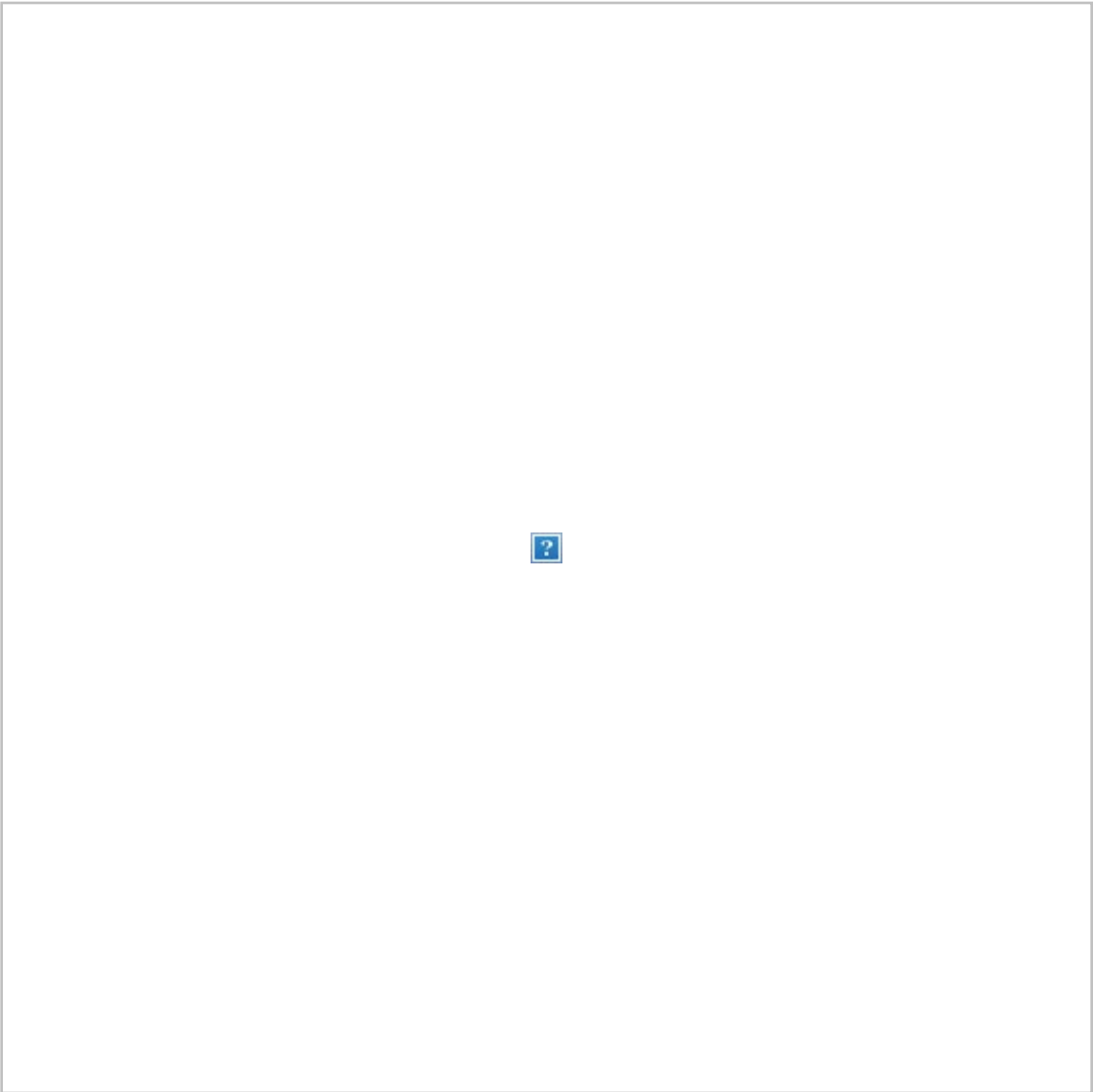
We will be hosting a Trade night on the 10th of March 2017 in conjunction with celebrating 20 years at the industrial estate. Hope to see you there!

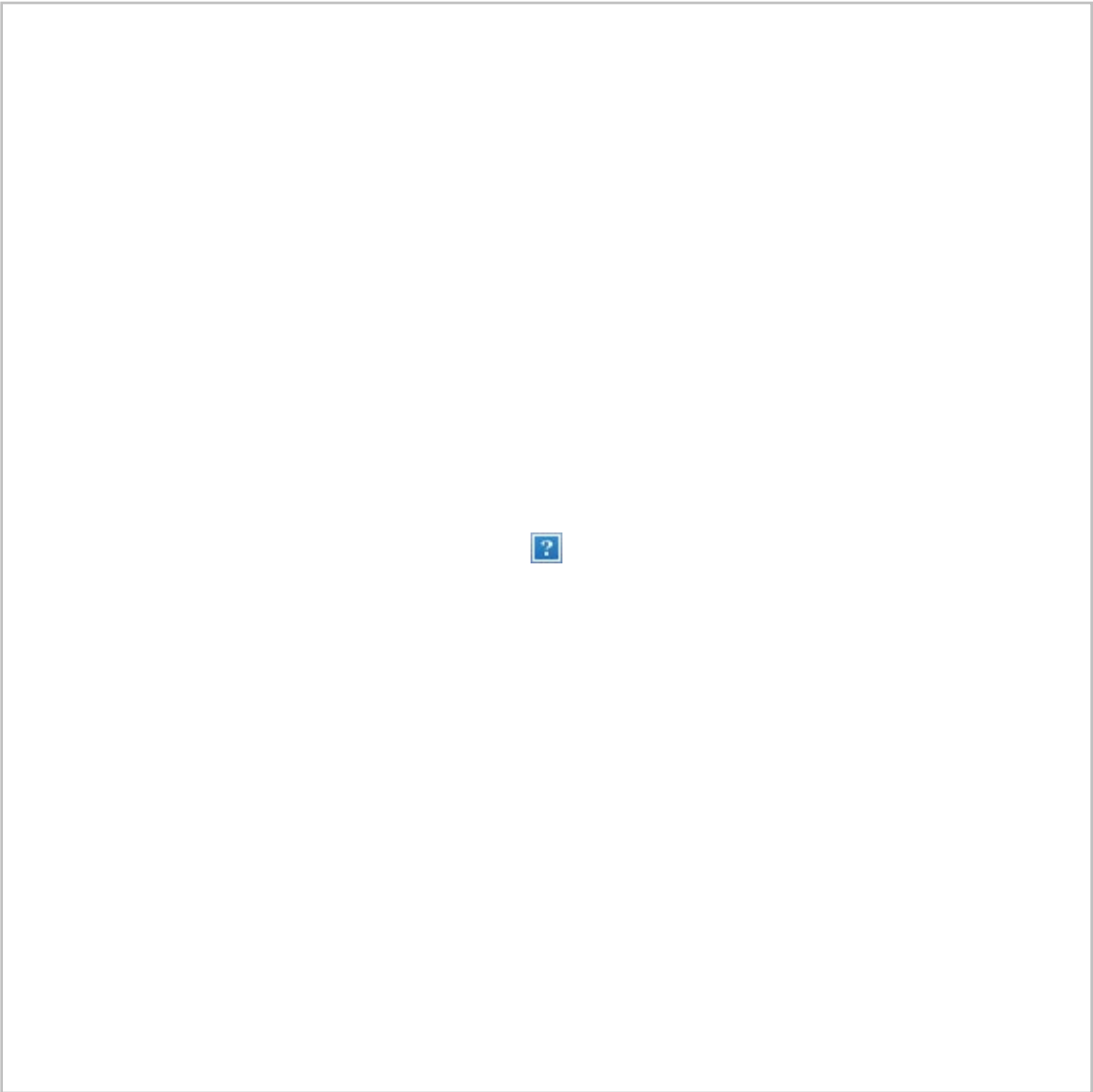




# Celebrating 40 years at Barry Maney Group

In June Todd attended the Cummins ISX CM2250 (E5) course in Adelaide to further his knowledge in maintenance and repairs of the current engine range.



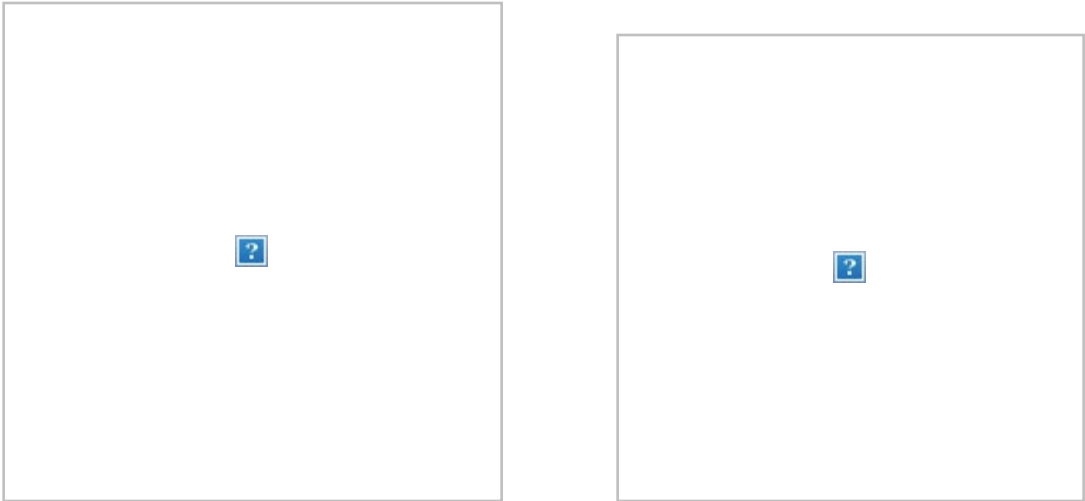
We have had a number of students spend their work placements through the school work experience program in our workshop over the last couple of months.
