Staff Training

Narelle Schneider travelled to Kenworth Melbourne for a level 2 parts interpretation course, July 10-12. The course comprised of special presentations from key suppliers including Meritor, Eaton, Donaldson and many more.

Steven O'Sullivan took part in the Kenworth air & brake systems and bendix ABS courses in Melbourne July 17-21. The air & brake course provided a basic understanding of the Kenworth air system and air suspension systems. While the ABS course provided an understanding of antilock brake system and developed problem solving skills in both areas.

Donna Clark & Shane Neale attended a Caterpillar warranty course on July 21st. The course was a refresher and provided information on the future in submitting warranty claims direct over the internet.

On the 21-25 August Adam Obst attended the course in Kenworth Premier Care Electrical Systems, Adam is now qualified to diagnose and repair faults associated with the electrical systems in a Kenworth.

Adam Keller took part in the Kenworth master steering systems course in September 25-27. The course looked at installation, maintenance, servicing, overhaul and repair of the TRW and Sheppard steering systems. It also covered the effect that wheel alignment, correct selection and fit of tyres has on the steering.

Shawn Lawson attended the Trailer parts specialist course at Kenworth in October 9-11. The course provided information on trailer suspensions, axles, brakes and took a tour of a trailer manufacturing plant.


