10 Years at Bordertown Industrial Estate

Inside this issue:

On Saturday 17th February Tatiara Truck & Trailers celebrated its 10th anniversary at the Bordertown Industrial Estate, which was the first business to relocate to the specially designed area.

John Jenkin has always had a passion for working on diesel engines. After leaving school in Year 10 he worked at Paynes Auto & Farm Service for 13 years before branching out to open a business in partnership with a fellow employee at a workshop in Seventh Street.

With the trends of trucks getting larger & the declining influence of rail transport it was considered that there was sufficient work available to develop a specialised business servicing the developing transport industry.

In 1985 the partners realised that the site in Seventh Street was inadequate & consideration was given to searching for an alternative site. Working from Seventh Street became increasingly difficult. There wasn't enough room to park trucks & neighbours complained about the noise & congestion.

The partnership between John & his original partner dissolved in 1988, however he continued on in partnership with his wife, Ann Jenkin until September 1993 when they formed a company, Tatiara Truck & Trailers P/L as it is today.

After looking at several options & involvement with the Tatiara District Council, land was purchased in the newly developed industrial estate in 1996. The completion of the premises was in February 1997, incorporating a specialised workshop with modern tooling & equipment, a showroom area, service, admin & spare parts areas & a recently developed training room facility.

Relocating has given the family business the scope to grow from what begun as a two-man show to become a national leader. This has also been made possible with the support from large transport companies such as Mackenzie Intermodal, McCarthy Transport, Martlew Bulk Haulage & Goodwin Freight Services who all started with a couple of trucks & now have fleets of up to 30.


As this was the first dealership that we gained from business in 7th Street, we have had a long and rewarding partnership.
