#### HORSHAM-9TH JANUARY 2010

After some more confidence building the team made the decision to head to Blue Ribbon raceway in Horsham. The team was greeted with a scorcher of 44°C. Having looked at the track some changes in the set up were made. A front row start in the first heat saw Dylan take his second heat win of the season. A boost in confidence was earned. A well driven second heat was all that was needed to keep in the top six point scorers. Dylan was happy with a 5<sup>th</sup> place, saving some rubber for the dash ahead. Being 4<sup>th</sup> in points was converted to a front row starting position for the A main due to being second quick in the time trail Dash.

A nervous wait and some minor changes in the set up saw the S51 starting on the front row for the first time in too many years. Starting along side multiple SRA sprintcar champion John Vogel's, Dylan knew he had to win the drag into the first corner. An awesome start and some great concentration saw Dylan lead every lap of the race, despite catching lap traffic early in the final and needing to be aggressive to get around them without coming to grief. He went on to record his first ever major feature race win. Huge relief would be just one way to describe that winning feeling.

#### HAMILTON-27TH FEBRUARY 2010

Since winning the maiden feature race at Horsham, Dylan has become a new driver and showed all of his potential by dominating the 30-lap A-Main event at Hamilton's Western Speedway.

Dylan made his presence felt in the top six time trial when he qualified fourth highest on points to set quick time on a racy Western Speedway in cool conditions.

Early in the final there were a handful of restarts. During this period, Dylan enjoyed the regular clear air to continue leading, coming out victorious and now a two time A-Main winner.

The Jenkin Racing Team started celebrations on the infield, with Dylan admitting these recent A-Main victories will give him momentum for the rest of the season.

"We've waited five years to get our first one and now to get our second win a month later is sensational. After the last win we got some momentum with the rest of our meetings so hopefully we can build on this win going into the end of the season," Dylan said.
