Jenkin Ready To Take Show On The Road

Dylan Jenkin is set to contest the full World Series Sprintcars season as a contracted driver for the first time in 2011/12.

In previous seasons work commitments have prevented the 26 year old from taking the S51 car around the country for the series. This year however, the family operated team is committed to racing.

"We have our business set up to cope with us being away this year, which has always been a problem over the summer." Said Jenkin.

"We always perform better when we're focused solely on racing, so I'm really looking forward to the challenge."

Jenkin has ample reason to be optimistic about his World Series Sprintcars prospects heading into the season after the team raced well in selected rounds last year.

"We finished last season really well and feel we have the speed necessary to compete," reported Jenkin, "we just had a bit of bad luck hampering our results."

In 2004/05 he was the Australia Sprintcar Rookie of the Year and has had success in the Eureka Garages and Sheds Sprintcar Series, winning in both Hamilton and Horsham.

"If we can make some of our own luck and keep that speed, it will really be our time to shine. I was rookie of the year in 04/05, so I hope to live up to that billing this season."

The focus for Jenkin Racing Team will be enjoying life on the road with WSS, make the most of any success, and try to learn as much as possible throughout the season.

"There aren't any external pressures on us to perform, so we feel we can really go out to race without the weight of expectation on our shoulders."

The team will build up to the World Series season by competing at the Sprintcar Masters at Speedway City, as well as at Bordertown and select other race meetings.

Dylan's father John will act as Crew Chief for the whole series, finally free of health concerns after 2 kidney transplants.

"Dad and I are best mates. We have a great understanding and work really well together, so it will be great to have him on the road."

The 25th Anniversary Season of WSS begins on November 26 in Brisbane, where Jenkin will set his sights on some early series points.

"We have the best equipment we've ever had to start a season, we're organized and we're ready to go racing."
